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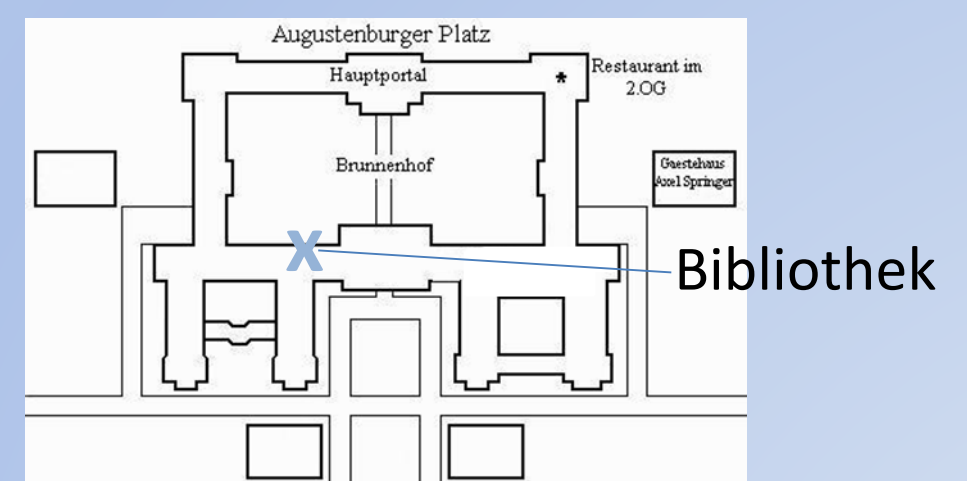
Sleep-disordered breathing represents a highly prevalent co-morbidity in cardiac patients. There is strong evidence for an independent prognostic impact of obstructive and central sleep apnea and its consequences, nocturnal hypoxemia and sympatho-vagal dysbalance, in these patients. Current evidence and recommendations will be summarized and recent major RCTs (SERVE-HF, SAVE) will be discussed.
